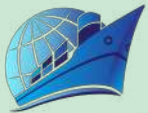

The DP World operated International Container Transshipment Terminal (ICTT) at Cochin achieved a significant milestone by handling over 81,000 TEUs (Twenty-foot Equivalent Units) in June 2025—a 35% increase over May 2025. This growth reflects the terminal’s enhanced throughput capacity and sustained performance efficiency.

In June 2025, DP World Cochin successfully handled 54 vessels, including several mother ships—highlighting the terminal’s operational strength and its critical role in India’s logistics ecosystem. short commute can cost 2–3 hours due to traffic congestion, **donating blood often becomes a logistical challenge.** For most working professionals, participating in traditional donation drives means:

- Leaving work for hours
- Navigating traffic
- Adjusting work schedules

EIC addressed this gap by launching a solution that brought the donation center to the donor, rather than the other way around.

A **fully equipped and medically supervised mobile ambulance** visited company premises, industrial zones, and logistics hubs, enabling entire office teams to donate blood with minimal disruption to their day.

“We wanted to remove every hurdle — whether it was time, location, or convenience — and deliver a fully compliant, door-to-door blood donation experience,” said **Anand Paranjape**, Founder Member of Exim Integrated Club.

Care, Compliance, and Donor Comfort

Each mobile unit followed strict **healthcare protocols**, in partnership with certified medical teams:

- **Pre-donation health screening** of each donor
- Safe, hygienic, and WHO-compliant blood collection processes
- Immediate post-donation refreshments and rest area
- Emergency medical backup on-board the ambulance

Donors felt confident and cared for, and many appreciated the professional yet approachable environment.

“It was the most convenient blood donation experience I’ve had — safe, quick, and right at our office gate,” said one donor from a mid-sized freight forwarding firm in Chakan.

Special Focus on Small & Mid-Sized Offices

Many logistics SMEs lack the infrastructure to host blood donation drives on their own. This initiative enabled even small offices to participate meaningfully:

- Just **5 donors** were enough to schedule an ambulance visit
- All coordination was handled by **EIC volunteers**
- Zero work disruption — donation done in under 30 minutes

“We wanted to ensure that no company — big or small — was left out from contributing to a noble cause,” said **Shreya Rokade**, campaign coordinator.

The 19th meeting of the Customs Consultative Group (CCG) was held on July 2-3, 2025, in Bengaluru under the chairmanship of Shri Surjit Bhujabal, Member (Customs), Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC), Ministry of Finance.

Since 2011, the CCG is the apex national platform for deliberation on all matters concerning customs clearance of merchandise in international trade. The Group comprises prominent representatives from industry chambers such as CII, FICCI, ASSOCHAM, FIEO, MAIT, NASSCOM, PHDCCI, STPI, as well as associations of logistics partners including customs brokers, freight forwarders, liquid bulk cargo handlers, port operators, and banks. This year 35 Export Promotion Councils and two associations representing the air freight sector were also inducted into the CCG.

The meeting witnessed active participation from senior officials of CBIC and its field formations, along with representatives from RBI, DGFT, Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS), Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Department of Posts, Ministry of Shipping, Airport Authority of India, Central Pollution Control Board, Animal Quarantine Department, Central Drugs Standard Control Organization (CDSCO), and the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI).

A total of 181 agenda points were sponsored by stakeholders and deliberated upon during the two-day event.

During interaction, Shri Surjit Bhujabal emphasised the critical role played by CCG in enhancing trade facilitation and fostering an enabling environment for ease of doing business. He noted that the CCG has proven to be a model of responsive governance, bringing about both policy-level and operational changes. He cited the previous CCG meeting held in November 2024, during which 116 out of 136 agenda points were successfully addressed through policy circulars, operational instructions, and the development of new subsystems under ICEGATE, the Customs clearance gateway.

Shri Bhujabal further highlighted the alignment of CCG's work with the National Trade Facilitation Action Plan (NTFAP), which synergizes multi-ministerial efforts on trade infrastructure, policies, and regulatory frameworks.

Key decisions taken during the meeting included:

- Introduction of a new policy on the discharge of bulk liquid cargo, enabling optimal utilization of limited port storage infrastructure.
- Development of a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP)



for duty drawback claims on jewellery sold at international exhibitions.

- Review of the Authorized Economic Operator (AEO) framework for enhanced trade facilitation.
- Strengthening collaboration between CBIC and the Department of Posts to support small exporters.
- Complete shift to the e-Bank Guarantee module to simplify regulatory compliance procedures.
- Agreement to conduct field-level studies to assess specific trade concerns and identify avenues for further facilitation.

Several sector-specific presentations were also made during the meeting. The Gems & Jewellery Export Promotion Council presented insights into the lab-grown diamond sector. The Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) detailed the Quality Control Orders (QCO) framework and offered guidance to trade stakeholders on compliance. The Department of Posts showcased the work done by the Dak Ghar Nirayat Kendra, a national initiative supporting small exporters, jointly implemented by DoP and CBIC. Additionally, the Chairman of JNPT provided an update on the proposed mega-port project at Vadhvan, Maharashtra.

The 19th CCG meeting reaffirmed CBIC's commitment to continuous stakeholder engagement, policy responsiveness, and further streamlining of India's international trade ecosystem.

showcase the best of India through our retail chains across the UAE and Gulf region,” he said.

From India, Chairman of APEDA, Shri Abhishek Dev, in a message, reaffirmed APEDA's commitment to enhancing the export of agricultural and processed food products, including premium horticultural produce such as mangoes. “APEDA has facilitated the airlifting of diverse mango varieties from Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, West Bengal, and Madhya Pradesh. This initiative not only celebrates India's mango diversity but also generates significant export opportunities for Indian growers and supports the farming community,” he noted.

In addition to fresh fruit displays, the promotion featured a curated selection of mango-based culinary delights, including:

- **Bakery and desserts:** Mango pastries, Swiss rolls, doughnuts, macarons, mango bread, and cakes
- **Traditional Indian dishes:** Mambazha payasam, mango pulao, mango fish curry, mango chutney, and mango kichadi
- **Snacks and salads:** Mango fritters, chaat, raita, tropical salads
- **Global fusion:** Mango sushi, mango-stuffed chicken, mango chapli kebab
- **Pickles and preserves:** Mango-dates pickle, garlic mango pickle, Kashmiri-style pickles
- **Beverages:** Fresh mango juices, smoothies, pulps, jams, and jellies

The UAE remains the top export destination for Indian mangoes. In 2024, India exported over 12,000 MT of mangoes worth USD 20 million to the UAE, demonstrating strong demand for Indian produce.
